## **Mission Grant Highlights**

### **Water and the Word for Rural Schools in Kenya: \$80,000**

Following the initial development and installation of water-harvesting equipment, filters, handwashing stations, and clean water storage at schools in Kenya, a team of LCMS members from Nebraska took over the management of the project. Nebraska teams continue to travel to schools in Kenya to assess water needs. This mission grant helps the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Kenya extend their ministry of Word and Sacrament by expanding the clean water project for more identified schools and orphanages.

### **God's Word Changes Everything: \$95,000**

Lutheran Bible Translators is training people from churches in Ethiopia and Tanzania to translate the Bible into their own languages as a part of seminary training. This mission grant is being used to equip pastors and lay leaders in the translation of God's Word in the numerous local dialects for the benefit of their Tanzanian and Ethiopian people in their everyday worship.
