- confess and repent of their sins; believe in the Triune God, and in Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior;
- believe that they receive Christ's true Body and Blood with the Bread and Wine for forgiveness of sins, new life and salvation;
- promise to change their sinful life with the help of the Holy Spirit.

Oneness at the altar requires oneness in doctrine, faith, and life (Acts 2:42). Therefore, "Let each person examine himself, and thus eat of the bread and drink of the cup" (1 Corinthians 11:28)



Social Ministry Announcement About

"Keep the Fires Burning"

The latest program of Michigan area St. John's Lutheran Church is a program to help households of the flooded Edenville and Sanford Dam area replace their damaged furnaces. The floods have subsided, but the devastation is still felt as people work to put back together what they've lost. With cold temps upon us timing of this program is crucial.

Individuals must fill out a form for assistance and be interviewed to see if they meet the criteria St. John's has in place for this assistance. Criteria being: Income is less than \$61,000 and their furnace was damaged in the flood. This program is in partnership with Wild's Plumbing and Heating.

One furnace is already being installed, another approved for installation, and three more applications have moved to the step of getting cost proposals by Wild's. One to two applications are received per week.

Financial backing for this project is supported by St. John's Social Ministry, application for a grant from Missouri Synod Lutheran Church, and from our church members. Donations for this project can be brought to St. John's Lutheran Church in Rogers City. Please write checks to St. John's Lutheran Church and include "furnaces" on the memo line.
