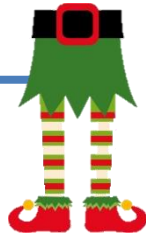

Volunteer Opportunity: Scrip Cards

We are looking for someone to handle our gift card fundraiser. It is a year around position that involves placing online orders, making bank deposits, having order forms available, producing treasury reports, dividing the orders, and getting the orders to those who ordered. What are Scrip cards? Various gift cards are available for purchase. The buyer receives the full amount of their purchase. Example: If you pay \$25 for a Home Depot gift card, you get to spend \$25 at Home Depot. Each card provides the school a percentage back. Purchasers can choose whether the full profit goes into the scholarship fund or if they would like half of the profit to go into the scholarship fund and the other half toward a St. John family's tuition balance. The volunteer who takes this position must have time for it and be very good at organization.

A Word about Gradelink

Gradelink is the student information system we use. Parents can use Gradelink to keep track of their child's grades and log in their volunteer hours. Your Gradelink user information was sent home today with your child.

Tally Information: Volunteer Hours

50! No, that is not the age of the principal, but a Gradelink school-wide default for the number of volunteer hours. The number cannot be customized per each family's needs, ergo, we just have to deal with the fabulous 50! Please log the required number of hours that your family needs, and know you can always do more!

How to calculate required number?

5 Day a Week Program = 20 hours per school year

3 Day a Week Program = 16 hours per school year

4 Day a Week Program = 12 hours per school year

2 Day a Week Program = 8 hours per school year

***Scholarship (Tuition Assistance):**

Add an additional 20 hours per school year

***Each additional child:**

Add an extra 4 hours per school year

How to log Volunteer Hours on Gradelink

- Login to Gradelink.com
(If you have multiple children enrolled, go to oldest)
- Click on the SERVICE HOURS tab.
- Click on ADD ENTRY.
- Enter in your Parent Volunteer Hours.
- Enter supervisor of job/event or teacher's name.

Viola! This form will collect your info and keep a running tally of your family's volunteer hours.
