Free COVID Testing in Alpena

Getting tested for COVID-19 doesn't need to be a hassle; it can be free and easy. Michigan Department of Health and Human Services is holding testing this Saturday, February 13 from 10:00am until 2:00pm at the Alpena County Fairgrounds' Merchants' Building, 625 S. 11th, Alpena, MI. There is no pre-registration, insurance, prescription, or doctor's order needed. The only thing they ask is that you do not eat or drink within 30 minutes of your test.
