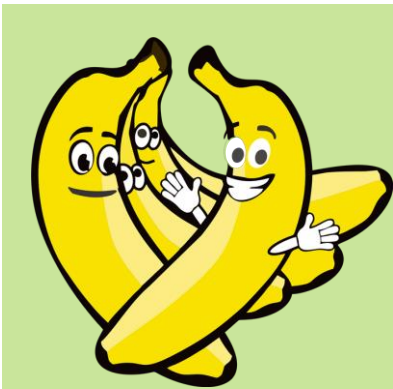


Congratulations to Our “Lynns”
