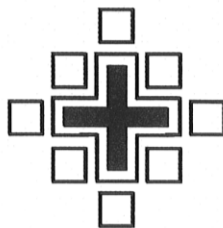

Choir Planning: An organizational meeting of choir will be held Saturday, August 21 at 11am.


August 22 Coffee Bar will be going before and after church. Join us for a great time of Sunday fellowship.
