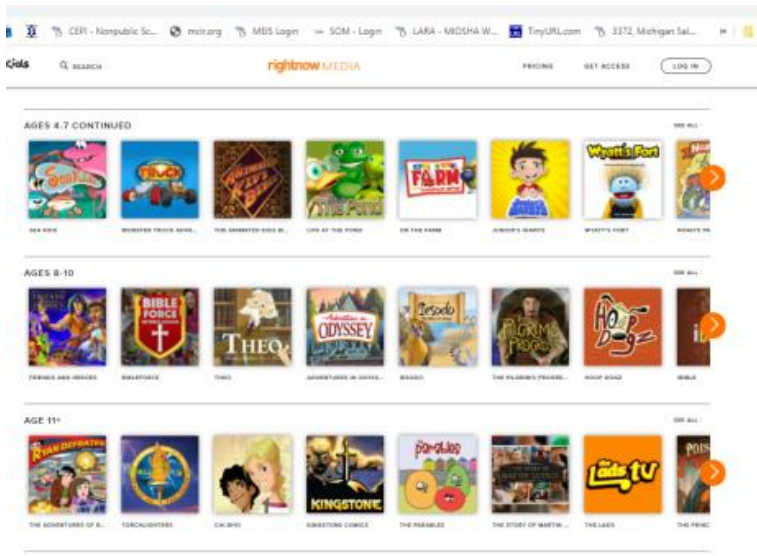
Friday Office Attendant
