Our prayer families this week are the Purois and Mackins. Please keep them in your prayers. Next week, include Lyndon Saucier's family on your prayer list.

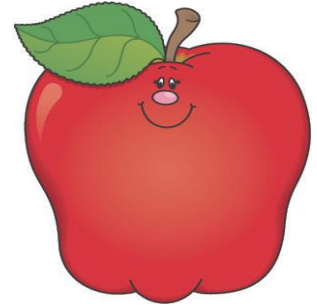
May Is Almost Here! Can you believe it?
