

#### Looking For Cabbage



#### **IMPORTANT REMINDERS:**

- Please call the school office by 8:10 a.m. if you know your child will not be coming in to school for that day or will be late.
- Please send a signed note to school with your child for their teacher if they are going home in an unusual way (i.e. picked up by someone new).
- If a child will sometimes be bused to a location other than their home, parents will need to fill out a busing form in the school office.
- To ensure their safety, students are not allowed to leave the building during the school day without being signed out by the parent or a responsible adult. Parents should stop by the school office and sign their child in and/or out and request that they be called from their classroom.
- St. John shirts should be worn every chapel day, with no jeans or athletic pants/shorts. Any shirt or sweatshirt with the school name or logo is acceptable.

#### Hot or Cold? And Snack Time

Make sure your child knows if they are having hot lunch or cold each day. You are welcome to send them with a note for the teacher. FYI: Milk is available for 25 cents for cold lunch students.

Send some snacks! Most students need a snack during each school day. If a child needs a snack, we will provide one, but will charge a breakfast fee.

#### School Opening & Closing

For the safety of our students the school doors will only be open at the beginning and end of the school day. If you come to the school when doors are locked, ring the bell, listen for a buzz and pull open the door. There will be someone in the office throughout the school day, who will be away from the doors only when necessary and for no more than a few minutes.

**7:40am:** School doors open for student arrival. Except for special circumstances, please do not come to school earlier than 7:40am. Until 7:40am, school staff is busy preparing for the day and sharing a devotional time together.

7:55am: School begins. 2:30pm: Doors open. 2:45pm: School ends.
