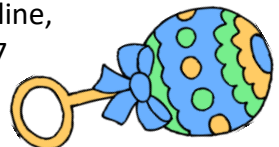

Celebration Sunday

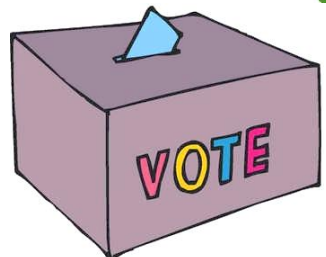

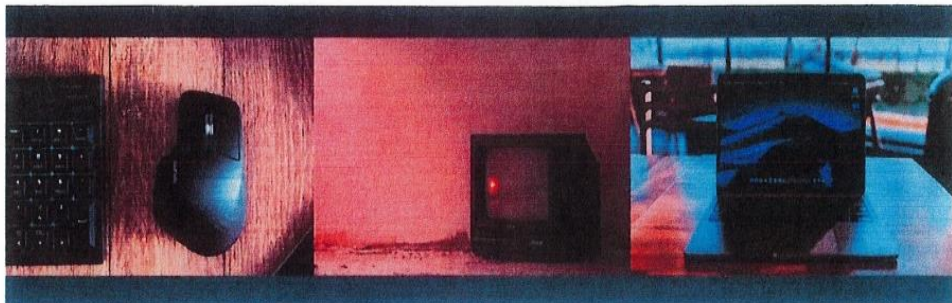
