What We Covered in Professional Development

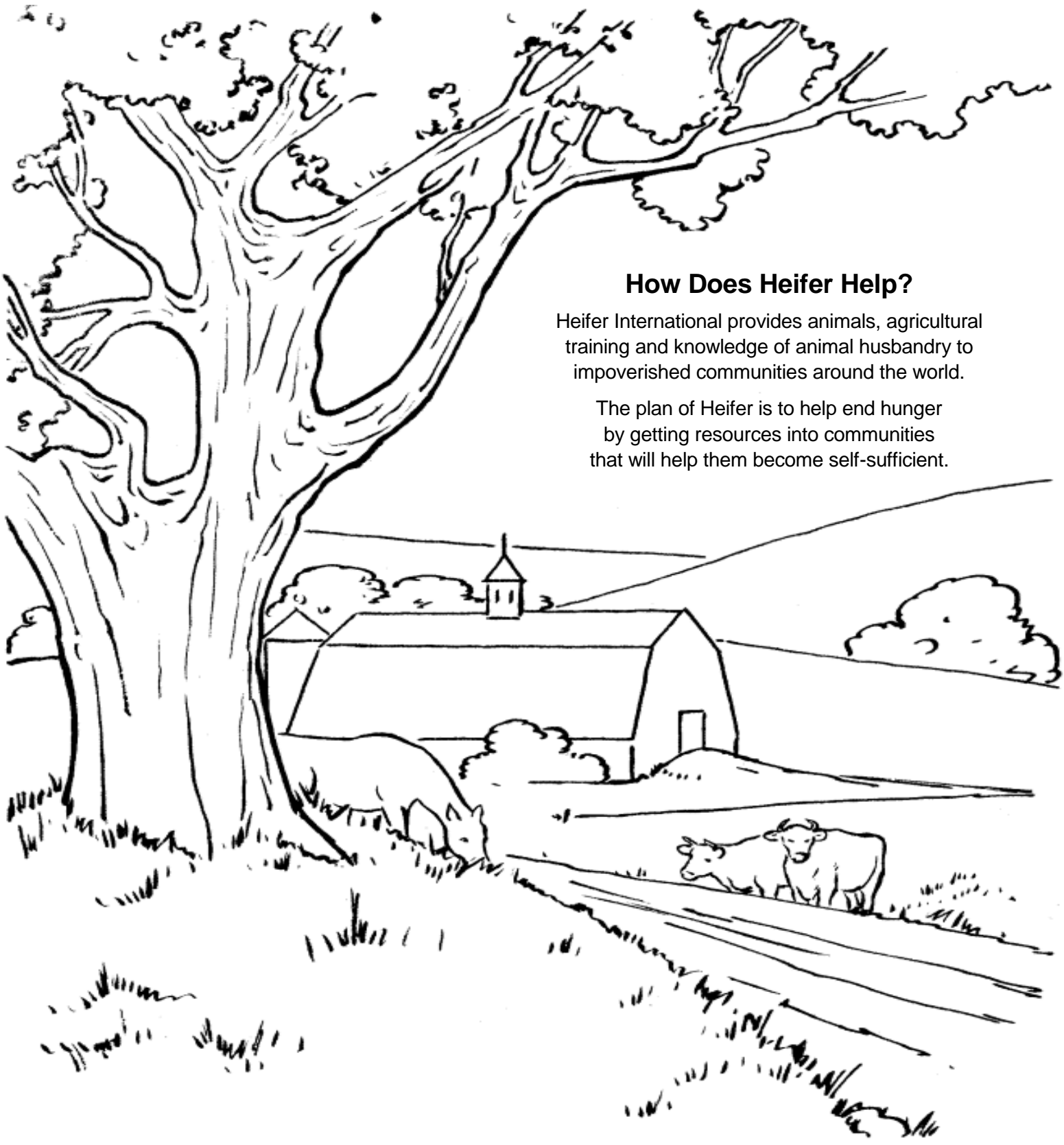
St. John's educators engaged in professional development on Oct. 28. The following is what was discussed. If you are interested in any of these items, ask our principal or one of the teachers for more information.
